

## Instructions for Printing the Seventh Edition Errata

The Seventh Edition Cancer Staging Manual, Handbook and Staging Forms Errata are now posted on the Publications and Electronic Products page of the AJCC website. Each of the PDF files include all of the corrected pages in a printable format for you to download to your computer and also print.

**Please be aware: The errata files contain many pages and it is suggested that you do not print the entire document at once.**

If you would like to print individual pages, a series of pages, or several noncontiguous pages you should use the Print Options menu.

To print just an individual page that you are viewing, single click on Print from the menu. That will open the print dialogue box where you can modify the Print Range. If you would just like to print the one page that you are currently viewing, select current page.

If you would like to print a series of pages, such as a group of pages from a specific chapter, select pages and type in the range of pages you would like to print.

**For example, 18-21.**

If you would like to print a number of pages that are not all contiguous, type the individual pages or ranges followed by commas.

**For example, 2, 7, 13-18, 32, 47-51**
